DAY 01 ARRIVE INCHEON / SEOUL / JEJU

Lunch / Dinner

Upon arrival at Incheon International Airport, meet & greet with our representative then proceed to process for Seoul city tour. Tour visit: **Kyongbok Palace and the National Folk**, through the Blue House. Kyongbok Palace, The Kyongbok Palace or the Gyeongbokgung Palace is one of the Five Grand Palaces that were built during the Joseon Dynasty. In English, its name translates to "Palace Greatly Blessed by Heaven." This structure has been famous worldwide because of its sheer size and unique architecture. National Folk Museum is a museum which displays over 4,000 artifacts that were used in the daily life of ordinary citizens Korea from ancient times until now. **Presidential Blue House** is the official residence and office of the president of South Korea. Then visiting, **International Mosque in Seoul**. After lunch, transfer to Gimpo Airport for departure flight to Jeju Island. Upon arrival, Half day tour to **Yongduam Dragon Head Rock and Mystery road**. Overnight in Jeju Island

DAY 02 JEJU ISLAND TOUR

Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

After breakfast, visit **Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak**, also called 'Sunrise Peak', is an archetypal tuff cone formed by hydrovolcanic eruptions upon a shallow seabed about 5 thousand years ago. Seopjikoji is located at the end of the eastern shore of Jeju-do Island. "Seopji" is the old name for the area, and "Koji" is Jeju dialect meaning a sudden bump on land. On Koji hill which is wide and flat, there stands a stone Bongsudae called "Hyeopjayeondae" with a 4m height and 9m length and width that has retained its original form. Then, visit **Sung-Eup Jeju folk Village** and **Cheonjijyeon water fall**. The water at Cheonjijyeon Falls, meaning "sky connected with land," Check in hotel after dinner. You can see the beautiful sea roads of Jeju Island. Overnight in Jeju Island.

DAY 03 NAMI ISLAND / MT. SORAK

After breakfast at the hotel. Check out hotel. Fly back to Seoul, proceed transfer direct to Nami Island. Enjoy **Lake Cruise** and take a leisure walk at the beautiful tree road where the outdoor shooting for the famous Korean Drama "Winter Sonata". After that, visit **Petite France**. After lunch proceed to **Gangchon Rail Bike Ride @ Samcheok Ocean Rail Bike** then shopping at **Daepo Warf & Seafood Market**. Check in hotel in Mt. Sorak

It's surrounds a wide stone site, and covers some 250,000 square meters. This fortress is believed to have been named after two generals, Kwon and Gum. (If cable car is not operated by any reason- will take cable car at Seoul N Tower). Then, transfer back to Seoul then free shopping at **Gwangjang Market** for buy Korean Silk. Check in hotel & rest.

DAY 05 EVERLAND THEME PARK

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the **Everland Theme Park** (pass-in the day) which is indoor and outdoor theme park. (Customer can change to **LOTTE WORLD** without additional charge - Free Tickets). Next, shopping at **National Ginseng Center** and was briefed about the various types of ginseng and the quality and usefulness, **Cosmetic and Amethyst Factory Store**, better known as the factory of precious stones. Guests have the opportunity to see a wide selection of gemstones and gemstone exhibition also taken from the purple mountains inland stalaktik in Korea.

DAY 06 SEOUL SHOPPING TOUR

After breakfast at the hotel, visit **Korean Traditional Hanok Village**, after that shopping at **Pine Tree Center** and Korean cosmetic duty-free shop, **Donghwa duty free department store** that sells a wide range of branded goods and sell a variety of items such as handicraft products made in Korea. Then free shopping at **Namdaemun Street Market & Myeongdong Fashion Street**. Next guests brought to visit **Seoul N Tower and Love Lock Wall**. At the top of Namsan, guests can take a picture at the Namsan Tower, also known as "Seoul Tower" which was built in 1969 and is a landmark of Seoul. It serves as a communications tower and the observation tower. Love Lock Wall also located at the top of Namsan Seoul Tower. (NOT INCLUDE OBSERVATORY). Visit **Bibab show** it is a nonverbal performance based on the Korean representative dish, bibimbap (rice mixed with vegetables and beef). As a nonverbal performance, the actors mimic the sound of making bibimbap with beat-boxing and a cappella, demonstration of motions through b-boying, and acrobatics and martial arts. **Hero drawing show** is an innovative art performance that stages the mind-blowing skills of live drawing with incredible visual effects filled with a witty blend of mime, dance and comedy right before your eyes and **Drum cat show** is a recognized as Korean performance, It's created in 2003, is an all-female percussion group. (Depend on ticket availability). Transfer back to hotel & rest.

Dinner : served at a Muslim restaurant
